List of what you need to register your intent to Marry in Ireland.

- ❖ *Your Birth Certificates plus photocopies. You will get these if needed at your HSE office. They charge for the document, so do check before hand.*
- ❖ *Passports plus coloured photocopies*
- ❖ *Proof of address for both of you. A recent utility is fine.*
- ❖ *Name and address of priest and address of church if applicable*
- ❖ *Name and DOB of witnesses*
- ❖ *Your PPS number*
- ❖ *And €200 euro*

3. *Make a further appointment to register your marriage with your two witnesses generally before your wedding day.*

On your wedding day, you will say your vows, exchange rings, add rituals, readings, music or even a slide show in a fun, relaxed, meaningful, intimate ceremony!
